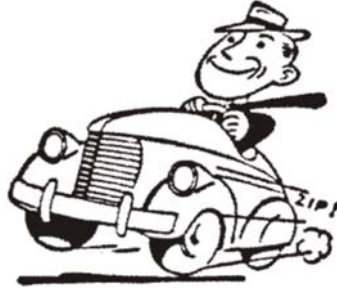

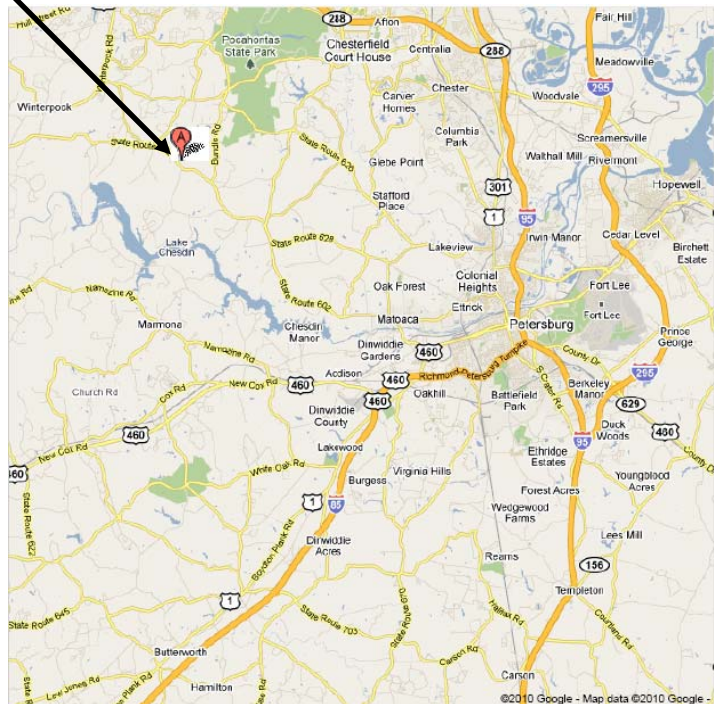
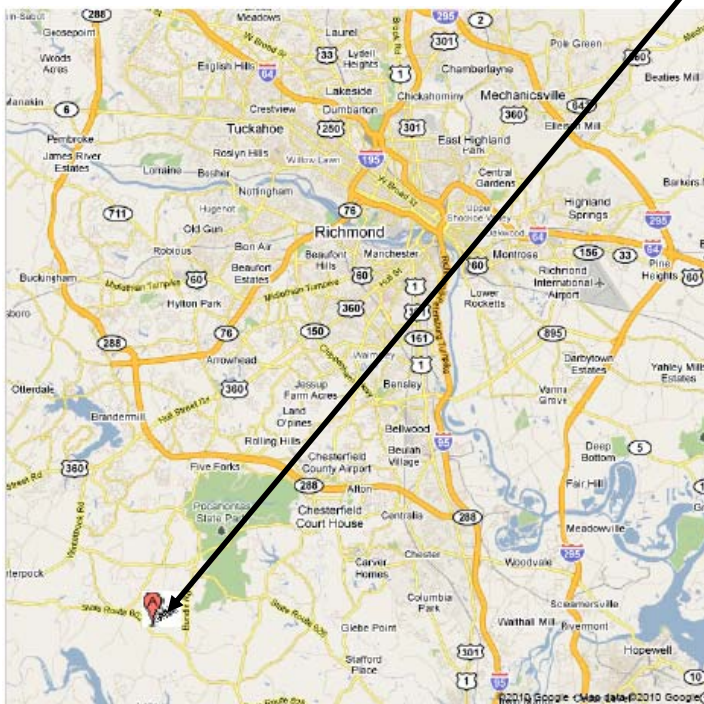


From northeast of Richmond: I-95 South to the 288 N Exit (Exit 62). 6.3 miles on 288 N, take the Iron Bridge Rd. (VA 10) E exit (towards Chesterfield). Approx 2 miles, turn right onto Beach Road (State Route 655). Drive 5.6 miles, bear left at fork to onto Bundle Road (State Route 654). 3.2 miles on Bundle Road to “T” at River Road. Turn right onto River Road (State Route 602), drive 1.6 miles; K.T.’s house is on right.

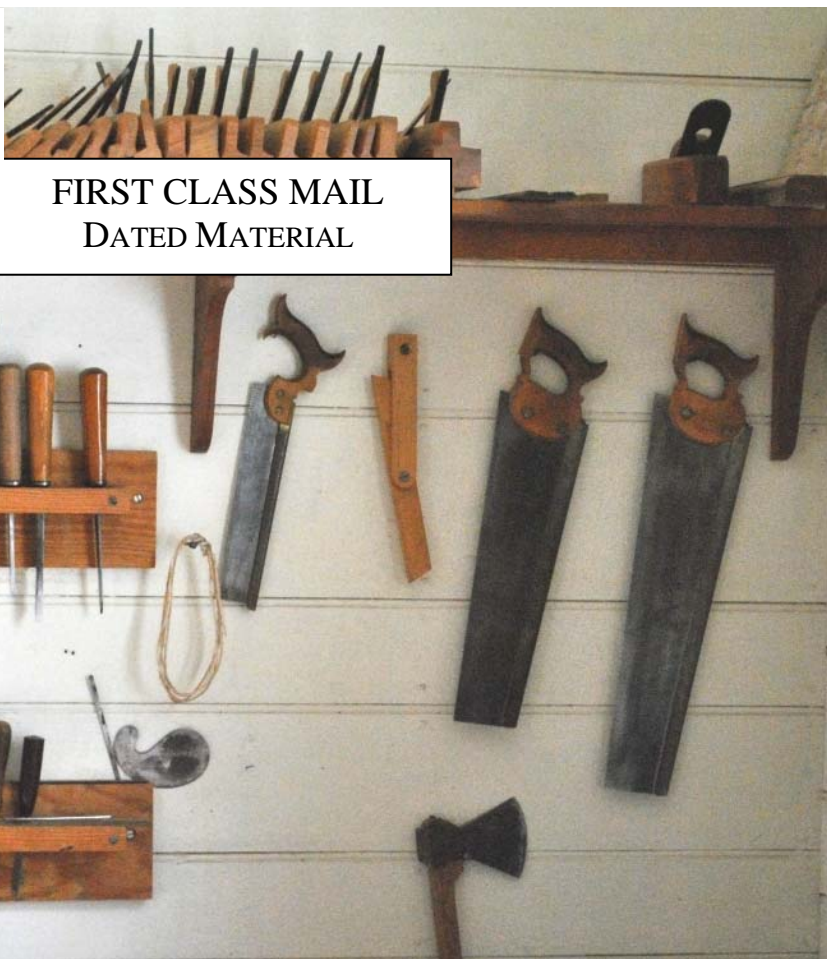
From northwest of Richmond: I-64 East to 288 S Exit (Exit 175). Approximately 18.5 miles on 288 S to Hull Street Road/U.S. 360 exit towards Amelia. 2.8 miles on Hull Street Road, turn left onto Winterpock Road (State Route 655). 3 miles on Winterpock, turn left onto Beach Road (State Route 655). 0.5 mile on Beach Road, bear right at fork onto Riverway Road. 2.7 miles on Riverway Road to River Road (State Route 602). 1.5 miles on River Road; K.T.’s house is on the left.

From south of Richmond: I-95 North to exit 50B-50C-50D for Crater Rd./Wythe St./Washington St. Take Exit 50D *on the left* for Wythe St./Washington St. Continue to U.S. 460 business E. Washington St. Turn left onto U.S. 460 business E. Washington St. Drive 3.8 miles, turn right onto Westgate Dr., which becomes Ferndale Rd. (State Route 600). Drive approximately 2 miles to River Rd. (VA 36). Turn left onto River Rd. Drive 9.8 miles; K.T.’s house is on right.
