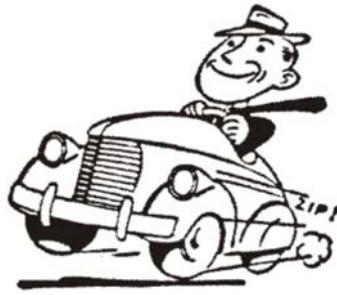

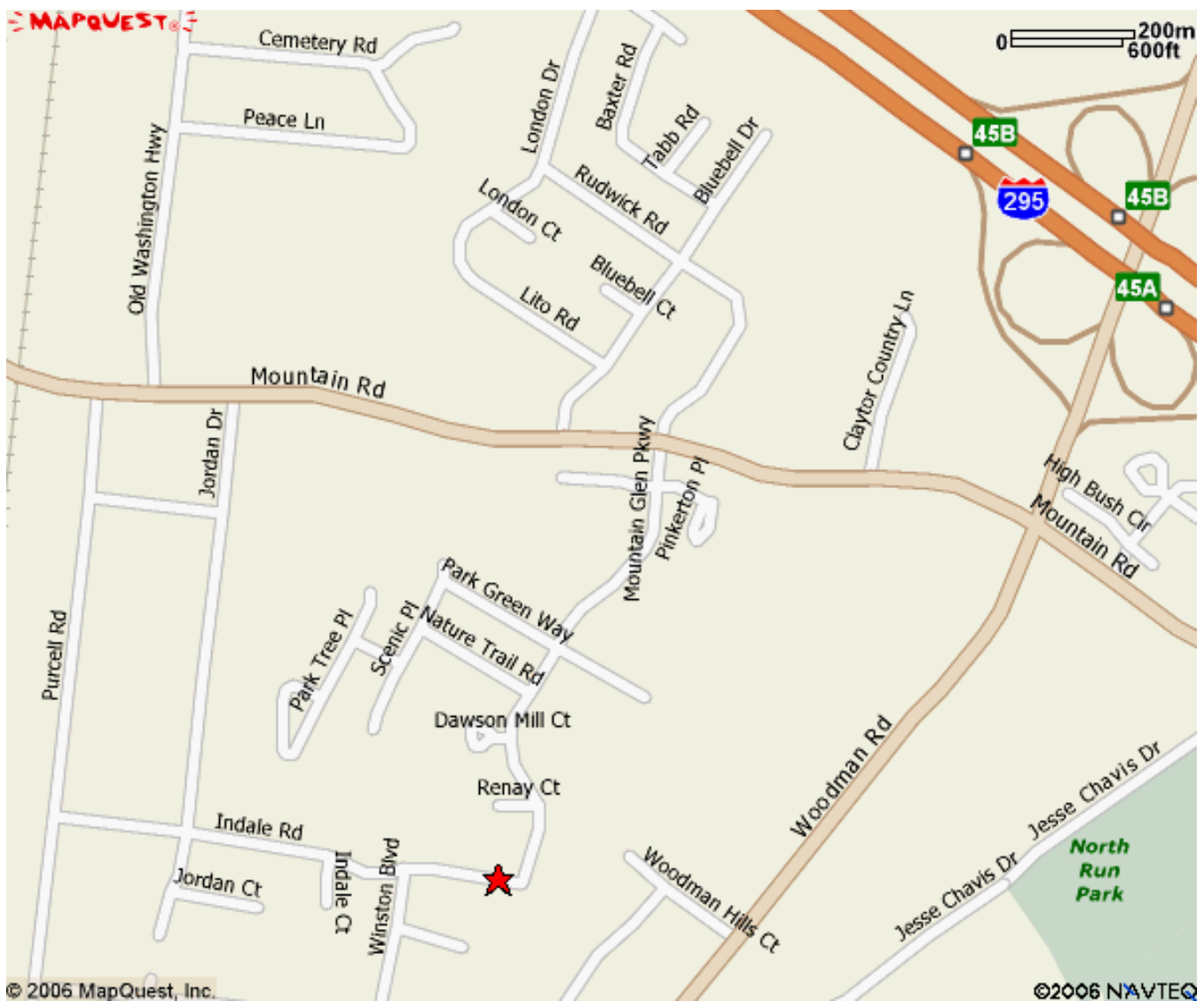

The Glen Allen American Legion hall is located off of Purcell Road, which is off of Old Mountain Road. Take exit 45-B off of I-295, north of Richmond, VA. This is Woodman Rd. South exit. You will quickly come to a light at Old Mountain Rd. Turn Right at the light, go 9/10 mile to Purcell Rd. Turn left onto Purcell. If you come to the RR tracks on Old Mountain, you went too far and just missed Purcell! Once on Purcell, go 4/10 mile to Indale Rd. Turn left onto Indale Rd. Go 3/10 mile and the American Legion Hall is on the left.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Payment in full for all tables shall be included with signed contract to MANAGEMENT.
2. EXHIBITOR shall not share or sublet a table without the prior approval of MANAGEMENT.
3. EXHIBITOR may cancel this agreement upon written notice to MANAGEMENT only if received 15 days prior to show opening day. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON AFTER THIS DATE. If the show is canceled, MANAGEMENT shall not be held accountable for any loss or damages beyond the full refund of any fees paid to MANAGEMENT. If the show, once opened to the public, is canceled prior to its scheduled closing time due to reasons beyond MANAGEMENT's control, no partial or prorated refund will be due to EXHIBITOR.
4. EXHIBITOR shall use tabletop for the sole purpose of selling Antique Tools, Antique Scientific Instruments, or directly related items, arranged so as to not interfere with the displays of other exhibitors. Modern tools and power tools manufactured after 1960 are not permitted in the show. EXHIBITOR shall cover all tables.
5. EXHIBITOR is responsible for themselves and their employees, materials, equipment, display, and all insurance to protect the above. EXHIBITOR EXPRESSLY RELEASES MANAGEMENT FROM ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY LOSS, DAMAGE OR INJURY ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS SHOW.
6. All EXHIBITOR displays and sales shall conform to applicable Virginia laws and regulations.
7. Security is provided by MANAGEMENT from 6:00 p.m. Friday until 6:00 p.m. Sunday.
8. Exhibitors must wear their name badges at all times during setup and during show hours. EXHIBITOR badges are for exhibitors only. Anyone not wearing an EXHIBITOR badge during setup will be asked to leave.
9. MANAGEMENT reserves the right to make changes and further rules regarding the show as it deems necessary and proper, upon notice to EXHIBITOR, all said actions become part of the Contract.
10. The terms of this contract shall be from the date of the acceptance by MANAGEMENT until 10:00 p.m. each show closing day. This contract will not be binding on the parties until MANAGEMENT has expressly accepted it.
11. **POSITIVELY NO PACKING BEFORE SHOW CLOSING TIME EACH DAY OF THE SHOW.** Packing early without MANAGEMENT's permission may result in forfeiture of the privilege to participate in future shows.
